



## **ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY**

Site issues such as waste, noise pollution and energy consumption are monitored throughout the contract and by the use of bench marks the awareness on site can be significantly improved.

Any environmental issues with a strong health bias such as asbestos removal will require the necessary risk assessment and method statement prior to work commencing.

Compliance with all relevant environmental legislation.

Raise staff awareness of the Company's own Environmental Policy and objective.

Provide appropriate staff training to employees with regard to environmental issues.

Monitor environmental developments in legislation and current thinking and amend Policies as necessary.

Carry out safe and effective waste management to minimise the Company's own waste management, as details in the Quality Control Procedures, and carry out regular audits to ensure compliance.

Examine and promote methods for the re-use of any waste created where practicable.

Encourage and support, wherever possible, the sustainable use of materials and services.

Make efficient use of natural resources.

Liaise and encourage clients, sub-contractors and suppliers to consider environmental issues, legislation and innovation to achieve environmentally friendly solutions.

Minimise air, noise, water and land pollution.

Minimise the Company's contribution to the release of carbon dioxide gasses into the atmosphere.
